BALLROOM

The 400 m2 oval room offers ground-level vehicle access and features an imposing cupola ceiling that can be lit in a variety of colours.

The Alcantara-clad walls ensure excellent acoustics.

There is space for up to three vehicles in the room; the floor load is 500 kg per square metre.

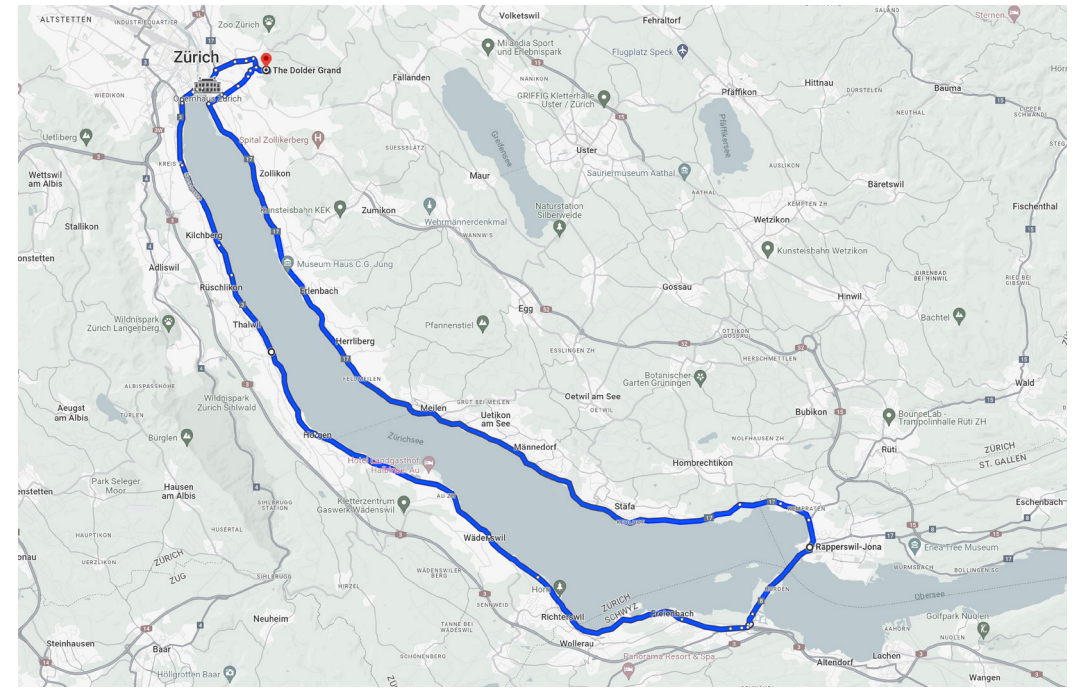
TEST TRACK 1

AROUND LAKE ZURICH

This tour takes you along the picturesque Seestrasse to Rapperswil. The old town with its medieval castle and charming lake promenade gives the town a unique atmosphere. The route continues along the Seedamm and a narrow bridge connecting the banks of Lake Zurich.

You can choose between two options: either use the picturesque Seestrasse or take the motorway back to Zurich. The tour covers around 74 km and offers a journey time of approximately 2.5 hours.

Overall route: 74 km



TEST TRACK 2

THE KLAUSEN PASS

This beautiful former mountain race track between Altdorf and Linthal spans 47 km and offers maximum gradients of 10%. The expansive high valley of Urnerboden is nestled between the 3,000 metre-high mountains of Central Switzerland and first became accessible to road traffic in 1899, when the road over the Klausen Pass was completed. The western descent towards Lake Lucerne offers breathtaking views and takes you past Bürglen, the home of Switzerland's national hero William Tell.

The road over the Klausen Pass is open from June to around mid-November. This pleasant tour covers 216 kilometres and lasts around four hours.

Overall route: 216 km
